

# UK UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS TESTS NOVEMBER 2020

## FEES, DEADLINES AND REGISTRATION

Subject-specific admissions tests are sometimes required when applying for certain courses at some universities in the UK and other countries. They help universities to differentiate between equally able candidates and allow candidates worldwide an equal opportunity. Not taking the required admissions test could result in an unsuccessful application to a candidate's chosen institution. This is why it is important that candidates refer to university websites, prospectuses, and UCAS for a definitive list of entry requirements.

We give students in Bulgaria the opportunity to register for and sit these tests at our centre in Sofia instead of travelling to the UK.

### WHICH EXAMS ARE THERE AND HOW DO I FIND OUT MORE ABOUT THEM?
